Dr. Waleed Khalil is a Professor of Electrical and Computer Engineering at The Ohio State University. He founded the Circuit Laboratory for Advanced Sensors and Systems (CLASS) in 2009, following a 16 year career at Intel . His research is focused on integrated circuits and systems, with applications in the areas of hardware security, wireless and wireline communications, heterogeneous chip integration, and image sensors. Dr. Khalil co-leads an AFOSR Center of Excellence, the Center for Enabling Cyber Defense in Analog and Mixed-Signal Domain (CYAN) focused on multidisciplinary research in the area of hardware-enabled cybersecurity through innovation and development of new AMS domain security, and Co-Directs MEST - the National Microelectronics Security Training Center. He authored 19 issued and several other pending patents, over 120 journal and conference papers and three books/book chapters.
